# IT New Budget Request Considerations

- ▶ Shared Services
- ▶ Alignment with Statewide Strategic IT Plan
- ▶ Alignment with Statewide IT Standards
- ▶ Details about what is being purchased
- ▶ Specificity around IT within the larger amount requested – Is there more than IT included in the request?

# Anatomy of an IT Budget Request (1 of 2)

Agency is requesting \$2,032,478 for infrastructure integrity and information security needs.

▶ **IT Integrity and Information Security Staffing – 7 FTEs - \$976,153**

- Project Manager I, Endpoint Technician II, Network Administrator, IT Customer Support Specialist III, (3) IT Security Analysts.
- Positions maintain network security, manage enterprise project implementation, expand user support services.
- Agency is a shared services customer. Positions outlined will perform work complimentary to shared services.

▶ **Bandwidth Upgrade – \$385,640**

- Bandwidth upgrade for 57 offices to support staff work approach changes and leverage solutions implemented due to COVID-19.
- Admin and Agency collaborated to add network capacity in response to use of video conferencing and other critical applications.

▶ **Network Management Software Maintenance – \$27,959**

- Recurring funding of annual maintenance/support for SolarWinds purchase to monitor, analyze and reduce risks to agency communication network.
- While network management software is a required tool, the use of network shared services may reduce this need.

# Anatomy of an IT Budget Request (2 of 2)

Agency is requesting \$2,032,478 for infrastructure integrity and information security needs.

▶ **Antivirus Software Maintenance – \$181,165**

- Recurring funding for annual maintenance for Cisco Advanced Malware Protection. This solution monitors all devices for security threats and attacks and isolates affected/infected hosts to respond and remediate security risks.
- Antivirus software is required, and Admin supports this request.

▶ **Upgrade to MS Unified Advanced Support – \$139,794**

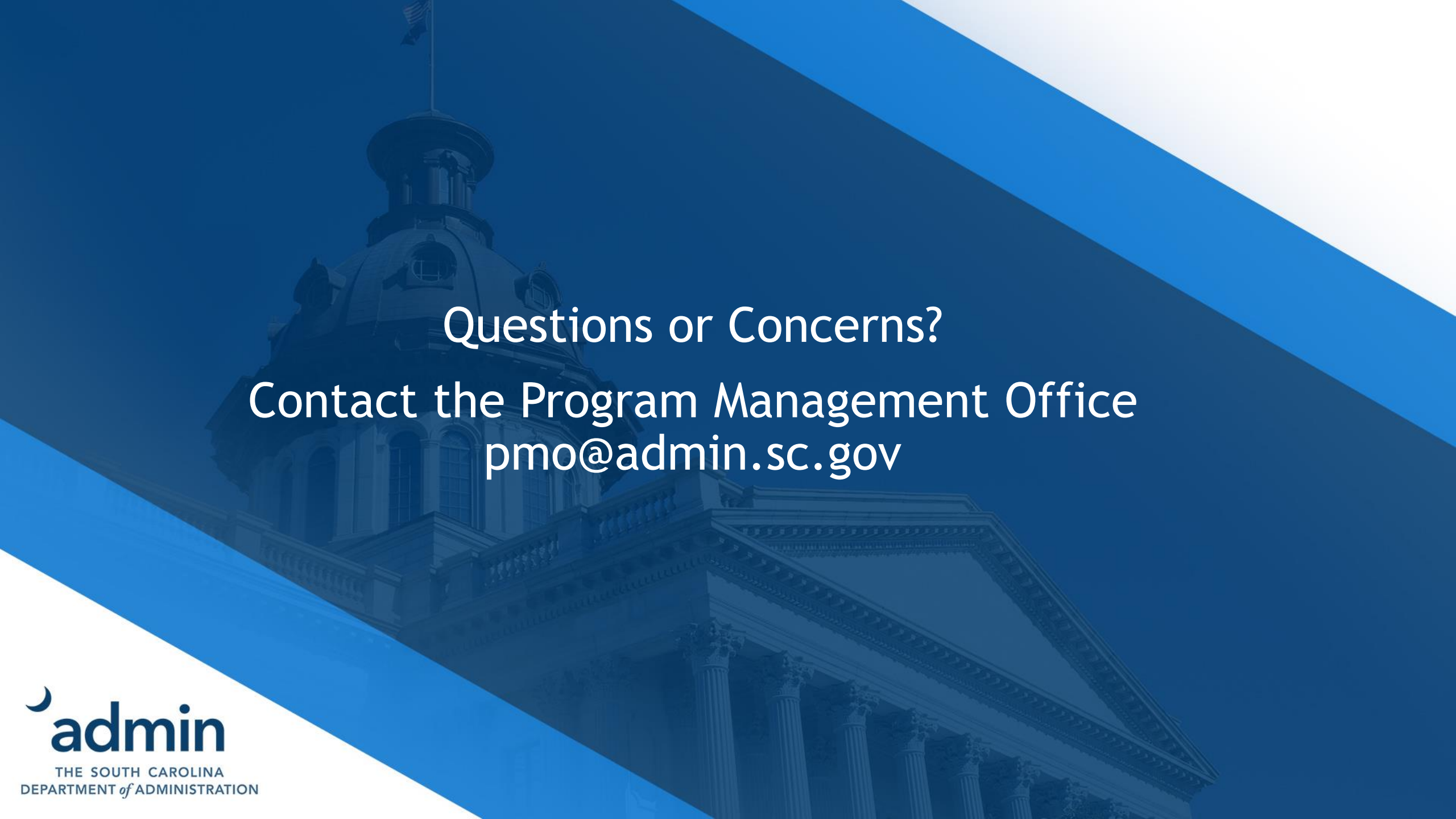
- Funds to move from Premier Class to Unified Advanced Support, including advanced suite of on-demand reports.
- Admin supports the intent to increase the security posture of Agency.

▶ **IT Upgrade to MS E5 – \$321,762**

- Funds to support Office 365 E5 tenant which provides broad spectrum of security enhancements and offers users a wide variety of tools to improve productivity, while gaining greater mobility.
- Admin supports the intent to increase the security posture of Agency.

# Human Resources Considerations

- ▶ Importance of HR where IT is involved – joint meetings with Admin’s DSHR and PMO.
- ▶ Alignment with DSHR new human resources budget requests.
- ▶ IT Planning now includes IT Personnel – workflow includes Admin’s OTIS and DSHR.
