New Initiative: Increased Transparency Services SCETV is requesting \$321,410 in recurring funds for three FTEs that would allow SCETV to support LSA's staff in scheduling and staffing legislative daily meetings that require streaming services. This would include a dedicated staff person to schedule and ensure adequate staffing for meeting coverage plus two program managers also cover the multiple ongoing state agency partner meetings and production and streaming needs for transparency and accountability including Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Public Service Commission and many others. In total, there are an estimated 300 state meetings that require coverage or some level of production and streaming services from SCETV. These positions will also allow us to work more closely and expand our work with SC Emergency Management during weather related events.

3 Production Manager II (midpoint \$64,885): SCETV is requesting three FTEs for Production Managers who will support regional work throughout the state. To amplify South Carolina voices, these positions will have primary responsibility for coordinating programming and production activities specific to regional communities. These positions will support production and engagement activities specific to television, radio and education/community outreach. These positions will facilitate increased collaboration, support and resource sharing between regional communities and partners, thus further leveraging their value to the network.

We are requesting funding to support the midpoint of the hiring range for each of these three positions. If these funds are not received, our agency will not be able to respond effectively to the growing needs for transparency services and statewide information distribution to the citizens of South Carolina.

We are currently realigning duties for existing FTEs to support evolving needs. Existing vacancies will be filled to ensure current operations are sustained as we continue to implement expanded, innovative practices.

In addition to the FTEs, SCETV is requesting \$500,000 in recurring funds to expand the availability of live streaming of government proceedings at state agency facilities that don't require a full-time studio set-up. This would include three mobile "tri-caster" cameras, switchers and high-speed mobile internet hotspots. This would also include ongoing maintenance, redundancy and upkeep plans to ensure consistency in the quality of and access to the streams.

The agency has completed an energy efficiency study and is currently working through the most feasible plan to implement recommendations. If funds are not secured, SCETV will need to explore alternative options for completing this work.

This request will allow SCETV to replace and/or upgrade vital HVAC and transmission infrastructure throughout the state. While dependable and efficient HVAC is certainly important to the comfort and well-being of the workplace, it's even more important at SCETV because of the tremendous inventory of technology that resides in all SCETV's buildings and towers. Inadequate temperature control can be devastating to highly sensitive – and expensive – equipment, much of which is vital to the operation of transmission towers and production work.

Much of the existing equipment is at the end of its useful life and repairs are becoming difficult. Additionally, with rising inflation and decreased availability of parts, replacing the units will be more cost effective than continuing to repair them and will also guarantee continued operations.

SCETV is requesting funding to replace and/or upgrade vital HVAC equipment at facilities

	including the headquarters building, Beaufort regional location, and transmitter sites across the state. This will help guarantee continued operations. Given SCETV's role in emergency communications and other services, maintaining a high degree of reliability for its infrastructure is critical. If funds are not received, we risk interruption of agency operations. Additionally, the upgrades will serve as a cost savings to the state as overall energy efficiency increases.

When SCETV's Telecommunications Center was built in 1998, two control rooms were the heart of where broadcast operations originated out of the two primary studios where educational, public affairs and cultural programming originate. As technology has evolved and equipment needs have changed over the years, two control rooms are no longer necessary.

Due to the age of the equipment and technology updates in recent years, these two primary studios have been increasingly served by a single control room located in the SCETV mobile unit truck parked just outside the building when the studios are in use. The truck, which had been purchased with the intent of being used for field production and revenue generation from rentals, has become an almost permanent control room for these two studios because the equipment in their control rooms had become outdated and unusable.

This single control room arrangement using the mobile truck has allowed the network in recent years to work more efficiently with staff, technology and scheduling so that only one control room is now necessary to serve both studios. In order to allow the mobile truck the flexibility to do the work it was intended to do field production and revenue generation), SCETV is requesting \$3 million in non-recurring funds to up-fit one of the studio control rooms (the second one would be converted to other uses) to serve both of the primary studio spaces. This single control room would ensure SCETV can be as nimble and flexible as possible to meet the state's needs.
