Repeal of the above regulations will bring consistency to both the regulations and the Ethics Reform Act. Regulations were not repealed to reflect the requirement that filings be completed electronically. The continued existence of these regulations has caused some confusion.

Perhaps more importantly, the regulations refer to April 15 as the deadline for required filers to file his/her Statement of Economic Interests. This deadline is inconsistent with the updated deadline of March 30 and has caused some confusion.
